Logistics and Housing Coordinator

Main Responsibilities

- Maintains and coordinates lists of available housing both on and off the center with arriving personnel in need of housing.
- Assists newly arrived personnel in finding housing, furnishings, etc.
- Plans and coordinates transportation for arrivals and departures.
- Handles correspondence related to accommodation needs and dates, maintaining updated records of arrivals and departures.
- Supervises work of all housing staff at the center, insuring that staff respond to newly arrived personnel in a friendly, efficient manner, sensitive to people's needs.
- May plan and provide, or assist with special arrangements for hospitality such as receptions or teas which may take place at the center.

If you enjoy people and like to extend hospitality, this job could be a really good fit for you. To do this job well, you need to have a learning attitude and creative tolerance with differences, while offering training and mentoring to those supervised or less skilled.

The need

There are about 7000 languages in active use and at least one book of Scripture exists in over 3,200 of these languages.

At least 1.5 billion people do not have the full Bible available in their first language. Over 684 million of these have the New Testament; others have portions or at least some level of work begun.

As of October 2016, estimates suggest between 165 and 180 million people speaking up to 1,800 languages are understood to likely need Bible translation to begin.
